Eligible wage now \$10/hr; Encourages hire of "Put Illinois to Work"-ers

Small Businesses

Businesses Hiring Put Illinois to Workers

Eligible if as of June 30, 2010, you

are a size business that hires a participant

in 2010

in the Put Illinois to Work program

with 1 or fewer full

Eligible Jobs

- Position filled by 20% "Put Illinois to Work" worker/trainee

Created between 7/1/10 - 6/30/11

- Position pays no less than \$10/hour or equivalent with minimum \$18,200 annually
- Position sustained for at least one year

Withholding tax goes to Illinois

- Hourly or full-time, but not partners or independent contractors

Tax Credits

- Certificate at six months and one year

Eligible Jobs

Created between 7/1/10

- Position pays no less than \$10/hr or equivalent with minimum \$18,200 annually

Position sustained for at least one year (not necessarily held by individual for the year)

Withholding tax goes to Illinois

- Hourly or full-time, but not independent contractors

Tax Credits

- Certificate after one year
