DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

VILLAGE OF UNIVERSITY PARK WILL AND COOK COUNTIES, STATE OF ILLINOIS


Upon the Authority of Chapter 20, Act 3305, Section 11 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, and the Authority of the University Park Village Code, I, Joseph E. Roudez III, Mayor of the Village of University Park, Will and Cook Counties, Illinois upon recommendation of the Village's Emergency Management Team, do hereby declare that a State of Emergency exists in the Village of University Park, Will and Cook Counties, Illinois for the following reasons:

The Village of University Park was notified of the presence of lead contaminants in the water supply on Friday, June 14, 2019. A Do Not Consume Order was immediately issued and the service provider informed the Village that the situation would be corrected within a "couple of days". Currently the situation has not been resolved and the service provider has failed to provide adequate updates or answers as to when the problem will be completely rectified.


Departments and agencies, charged with response and recovery activities under the Village of University Park Emergency Operations Plan, have been directed to respond with haste, in accordance with the plan, and bring said emergency to a rapid conclusion for the best interest of the residents of the Village of University Park, Illinois, pursuant to the Illinois Emergency Management Act and the University Park Village Code.

In accordance with the provisions of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, and the University Park Village Code, this declaration shall be in effect as of June 15, 2019 and expire at midnight on June 22, 2019 unless extended by resolution of the University Park Village Board of Trustees.
